

The first issue I will talk about is court sanctioning. We have two clubs that have not responded to the call for sanctioning their club pits in 2023. They are Arcade and Mid-Hudson. If you are no longer interested in being sanctioned, please let me know. If you are having problems getting this done, please let me know so we can try to

work things out.

My second issue is finding someone to be an Assistant Regional Director (ARD). I am the RD and from Western NY, Charles Reigles is the ARD and is from Southern NY area. We need a representative from either the Eastern or Northern NY area. If you are interested, please contact me.

The third bit of information is that I will no longer be sending sanctioned tournament certificates to our club's TDs. I used all my certificates for the tournaments scheduled for the first part of 2024 and when I contacted the NHPA to request more, I was informed that they were no longer necessary. So, in the future I will e-mail the Tournament Directors their NY number and the reporting token number for E-Shoe. Patches for the tournaments will still be mailed out or hand delivered as needed.

My fourth issue will be brought up at the spring meeting in April where I will propose that the NYSHPA raise its dues to \$40.00 dollars, starting in 2025. The current dues are \$35.00, of which \$25.00 goes to the NHPA and NY gets \$10.00. My proposal to increase our NY dues will include an automatic entry into the States 50/50 drawing. Currently we have approximately one third of our members who participate in this and if the dues increase is accepted all adult members will be included. I also feel that once we get 100% participation, we could payout at least four winners instead of just one. An example I have in mind is that if we have 200 members that would give us \$1000.00 into the fund and we would pay out \$500.00. 1 pick could be \$200.00, 2 could be \$150.00, 3 could be \$100.00 and 4 th \$50.00. I also think that we could just take the payout and split it equally between the 4 members drawn. Remember all payouts will be based on our membership numbers.

In closing I hope we have a great turn out for the spring meeting and that I look forward to seeing you all and getting your feedback on the issues concerning our charter.



A LITTLE FLASHBACK FROM FEBRUARY 2014

THREE OUT OF FOUR

"Three out of four" I used to hear from my friends at work who knew I liked to throw horseshoes. Sometimes it was a more modest "two out of three." They were referring to how many ringers were made by someone they knew, or someone else knew, whose prowess in scoring ringers was astonishing. These wonders of the courts were their friend's uncle or the brother of their neighbor down the street, who just couldn't miss throwing ringers.

At first, I was impressed, and somewhat envious – where did these 75% ringer pitchers come from? When I asked their names, I never heard of any of them. I would comment to whomever was telling me this remarkable tale that I knew a hundred or more pretty good horseshoe pitchers in the area who played in leagues or in tournaments, and only one of them could get "three out of four" with any consistency and even he (future New York State champion, Bob Hayes) rarely attained this lofty pinnacle.

One day I figured it out. I had taken a break from practicing at a public court, and when I resumed pitching there was an elderly fellow sitting on a park bench adjacent to the pit where I had left my four shoes. I picked them up and threw them to the other end. I don't recall what I scored, but when I threw them back, I luckily got three ringers.

As I walked back to retrieve my shoes, the old-timer commented words to the effect "that was pretty darned good!" I truly didn't know what he was referring to, so I asked what he meant. He said, "why, you just threw three ringers." Obviously, he was more impressed than I was, after all, I had done that once or twice before. Later it occurred to me that he might well have gone home and told his family or friends about this incredible horseshoe pitcher who threw "three out of four."

The point is we tend to remember the highlights and dismiss the mundane. There's a big difference between getting three ringers out of four now and again and averaging that. If this fellow really did go home and talk about "three out of four" he probably forgot about the times I made only one out of four, or the unmentionable, which is worse.

After that, when someone would tell me about an unheard-of horseshoe pitcher who threw "three out of four", I would invite them to my backyard where I would throw "three out of four" just for him. I warned him that he might have to be a bit patient!

It turns out that a pitcher who averages 35% ringers ought to score three ringers out of four shoes roughly once out of every nine tries. Even a 25% pitcher should get three ringers out of four almost once out of twenty. That may make it seem to be an infrequent event, but if someone happens to come along at just the right time, he can go off and tell his friends at work about the guy who throws "three out of four."

Hello my fellow horseshoe pitchers

I am always looking for anything to add to the MUD! I will continue to bring back flashbacks of the past. I enjoy all the stories that people have so please share them with me. Pictures are also welcome.

I will be having Knee surgery in March and hope to be on the mend so I can pitch more this year. Happy pitching


