Lance has been a member of the Northern Horseshoe Club since 1984 and a member of NYSHPA since 1985. As past President of the Northern Club he was the recipient of the Silver Shoe Award for his achievements. Lance has also been co-tournament director for the club for the past 5 years.

Lance is most recognized by most of us as Sec/Treasurer of NYSHPA which is the position he has held since 1993. He is also responsible for keeping us up to date with happenings around the state through the "MUD" which he started in January 1994. He undertakes the responsibility to have this published 4 times a year.

Lance, is also involved on the national level. He has been our delegate or chair at the past 7 national conventions held during a world tournament. For 1 year he was an assistant Regional Director. He was appointed Regional Director in September of

1994 to the present time. His duties involve providing information to pitchers on tournament schedules, providing sanction materials, sanctioning tournament sites and acting as the liaison between Paul Stewart 5th VP, of the NHPA, the State ARD's and the State Officers. He is also a rules committee member which meets every 2 years to evaluate rule changes that have been submitted to determine if they have merit and should be put forth to the World Tournament Convention Delegation.

We are sure that all would agree that Lance is a deserving candidate for the New York State Horseshoe Pitching Hall of Fame.
