Finally, in closing I want to remind all new pitchers and pitchers returning from being idle you must pitch 100 shoes to establish your average, and that you or the sanctioned members recording your shoes need to send me a copy of your results also save one for the tournament director of the first sanctioned tournament or sanctioned league you plan on pitching in.

Happy spring everybody!! The weather is getting nice, and we can finally get outside to pitch. Of course, there are only 4 clubs having tournaments because when I asked for all clubs to send a representative to the spring meeting so we could set up tournaments, only 4 showed up. There are many advantages to hosting a tourney. It gives members a chance to play competitively, it brings friends together, and it raises funds for the state. These funds generally go towards the state tournament. If we could get ALL the sanctioned clubs to host a tournament it would greatly help with keeping our sport alive as well as help our state. If you are unsure how to set one up, the NHPA has all the info, plus videos on how to set up horseshoe master on their website. On a good note, I managed to go on vaca-



The deadline to enter is **August 1, 2022**. All entries must include your 2023 NHPA card number and the correct pitching fees. **NO PHONE REGISTRATIONS!** You must be a New York State resident and have participated in a minimum of two (2) sanctioned events between August 1, 2022 and July 31, 2023 to enter. Your sanctioned events must be on file with NYS statistician Frank Kwiatkowski or with Eshoe.

ENTRY FEES: Men's, Women's and Elders Championship classes **ONLY** will pay **\$52.00**. All other Adults **\$27.00**, Juniors **\$2.50**, **non refundable after August 5th** (unless spot is filled by another pitcher). Each pitcher will **pay \$1.00** per game for scorekeeping and **\$1.00** per shift for judges and "stat " people. These additional fees are NOT included in the entry fee. Scorekeepers are to be paid before the game begins.
