Proposals from the spring meeting

#1 Change the dates for our State Tournament. – Charles Reigles proposed this based on cost of hotels during the holidays, people having other activities with family, the last holiday before school, a lack of tournaments in August and also felt that the host club should have the final decision on the dates. Ellen opened this up for discussion:

Dan Ough mentioned that any change would interfere with the Tri-County summer leagues planned each year for their club. Karen Graham stated that Pine Grove would not be able to change due to their club activities. Roger Chase mentioned that South New Berlin tried to change dates for one of their club events hoping to increase attendance and just the opposite occurred, and attendance went down. Jack Stenberg felt that our current dates were needed due to the holiday that gave us a rain date, and that it was critical to have that option. Gerald Bernard felt that moving our tournament to a date in August would also interfere with the World Tournament. After several minutes of discussion Ellen brought the proposal up to a vote.

Ellen called on each club represented, and the independents and the proposal was voted down and there will be no changes to the State Tournament Dates.

#2 Increase NHPA and State dues from \$35 to \$40. – Frank Kwiatkowski proposed this increase which would include an automatic adult entry into the States 50/50 drawing which is usually only 33 percent participation. If accepted, we could pay out up to four winners based on total membership. Frank also mentioned that after speaking to Karen some revenue could go to support our payouts at the state tournament and stop taking funds from the lower classes to ensure payouts for the championship classes. Ellen opened this for discussion:

Eric Conrad said the Tri-County members were not in favor of raising dues. Karen Graham said the Pine Grove club also discussed this and the majority were against dues increase. Ellen felt that instead of raising the dues we should use money from the funds NY State received from hosting the world tournament. **Ellen brought the proposal to a vote and the dues increase was not approved.**

Monies allocated to the State Tournament come from the \$1 fee and from our charter under By-law Article V #16 Association Assistance. After several minutes of discussing other ways to raise funds for our State tournament, Ellen suggested that the tournament directors who usually host our state tournament get together and discuss what amount would be needed to equalize class payouts. Jack Stenberg stated that usually \$3 dollars per entry are taken out of other class monies to fulfill funds for the championship classes.

Jack Stenberg made a proposal to change our By-law on Association Assistance from \$4 to \$7 to ensure no monies would be taken from other classes. Ken Fraser seconded this proposal. **Ellen brought this to a vote, and it passed unanimously**.

Ellen proposed that we should review the results after the 2024 tournament to see if this was effective. Jack made a motion to accept, it was seconded by Karen and passed unanimously.

#3 Having the Mud go digital only. – **Karen Graham** proposed that our newsletter go digital only due to the rising cost of printing and postage. Ellen also mentioned that the cost of stamps will be increasing to .75 cents. This proposal will take effect starting with the November 2024 issue of the Mud. Karen then mentioned that members could contact the mud editor with information but could also contact her to get essential information on our web site. **Ellen brought this proposal to a vote, and it passed unanimously.**

2024 New York State Horseshoe Pitcher's Association Championships

will be held on August 30th through September 2nd, 2024 at the Waterloo Ringers HC in Waterloo, NY.

The deadline to enter is **August 1, 2024.** All entries must include your 2024 NHPA card number and the correct pitching fees. **NO PHONE REGISTRATIONS!** You must be a New York State resident and have participated in a minimum of two (2) sanctioned events between August 1, 2023 and July 31, 2024 to enter. Your sanctioned events must be on file with NYS statistician Frank Kwiatkowski or with ESHOE.

ENTRY FEES: Men's, Women's and Elders Championship classes **ONLY** will pay **\$52.00.** All other Adults **\$27.00**, Juniors **\$2.50**, **non refundable after August 5th** (unless spot is filled by another pitcher). Each pitcher will pay **\$1.00 per game for scorekeeping and \$1.00 per shift for judges and "stat" people.** These additional fees are **NOT** included in the entry fee. Scorekeepers are to be paid before the game begins.

Are you registered for the 2024 World Horseshoe Tournament

To all NHPA members and friends:

Preparation is underway for the 2024 World Horseshoe Tournament in Kennewick, Washington in the Tri-Cities area at the Three Rivers Campus. We are excited to welcome you!

The registration deadline is Monday, **May 20th**, which means that all registrations have to be postmarked by that date. Rather than wait until the last minute, we are strongly encouraging everyone that is planning to attend to register as soon as possible. There are many moving parts to prepare for a World Tournament, including the major task of planning for the pitching divisions and preparing the pitching schedule. The earlier we have the entries, the quicker we can get a clear understanding of how the pitching schedules will need to be arranged.

There are multiple methods of sending in your registration: 1) online at https://www.horseshoepitching.com, 2) Mail...a much slower option where we hope that all entries are received that are sent, 3) Provide your registration to an NHPA Officer and they will forward those entries to Brian Poole, NHPA Secretary/Treasurer.

Keep practicing, keep spreading the word, and if you don't have enough tournaments to qualify this year...prepare to compete in Salt Lake City, Utah next year at the 2025 World Tournament.


