Court Etiquette ~by Grumpy Ole Man

Chasing Kids off my lawn and thinking about COURT ETIQUETTE. With the winter indoor pitching upon us, now would be a good time to review court etiquette. In no particular order or all encompassing, here are a few things that make the game more enjoyable for everyone.

- Don't remove any shoes from the playing area until the score has been agreed upon. Also a good idea to not touch your opponent's shoes for any reason. This will avoid any misunderstanding between players.
- Court traffic. Think of the outer edges of the concrete walkways and the court box as your boundary. Other than to retrieve a wayward shoe, you should "stay in your lane" and not be a distraction to adjoining courts.
- Cross over. If both players pitch from the same side, after the first player pitches, he or she should CROSS OVER IN
 FRONT of the pitching box to the other side while the second player crosses over from the back of the pit to his pitching position.
- Crossing over, part II. In most cases, you know walking down to the other end who will pitch first the next inning. So
 if both pitchers pitch from the same side, they should veer toward the correct platform for the next frame. Should
 players pitch from opposite sides, they should cross over automatically. There shouldn't be both players on the
 same platform at the same time.
- Judges. Should you call a judge, let the judge do their job. Stand back and wait for the judge's decision. Don't hover over the judge or ask questions. You have left the decision in his hands by calling him.
- Scorekeepers. Give the players your undivided attention. The players tell you what happened, you write it down. Avoid talking to spectators or players while games are in progress, helps in avoiding mistakes.

Quarter Tournaments: Quarter tournaments take place on the next Saturday after the sanctioned tournaments depending on how many players show up. The pitching fee is \$3.25 per players; of this \$3.00 goes to the Club for heat and lights. The winner gets all the quarters, unless Chuck Reigles has invented other rules for the day!

Use of the Club for Practice: There is a \$5.00 fee per player for practicing on the pits during hours when the player is not competing in leagues or tournaments. This fee is to be deposited in the lock-box located next to the front door. Players are expected to groom the pits, turn off the heat in the pitching area, and turn off the fans and lights before leaving the building.

State Tournament Hero:
