Inducted into the Hall in 1979, "Bill" was one of the most vigorous promoters, as well as well as a consistant 60% pitchers from Northern New York. At this writing, he was a devoted family man and the father of 5 children. Charles John, 31, Linda Jean Barkhartt, 30, Richard James, 30, and Kathryn J. Lattamore, 27. His wife of 32 years was nearly always present with "Bill" at the various tournaments he pitched in, and a faithful member of the NeOsCo 'auxilliary'.

"Bill" permoted many of the clubs activities for 10 years, and is presently vice president of the club. In 1977 "Bill" was the State president and tournament director. He won Class C in this year with 56%, and pitched in class A in 1976 and 1978.

A member of the Masonic Lodge F & AM he was a 32nd dagree member of the Scottish Rite.

He served in World War 2 for 3 years in the U. S. Air Force reaching the grade of seargent while on duty in China, Burma, India and the west pacific theaters.

Late in the year of 1979, the State Association was saddened by Bill's death, but his contributions will live in the memories of all who knew him, and will be greatful for his contributions to the sport of horse-shoes.
